TEACHING PURPOSE/SUGGESTIONS

Teach this song by rote. Because it is so repetitive, it's very easy to learn. Add the actions. Use a lot of expression when you sing.

CURRICULUM CONNECTIONS

Choral Reading: Read or sing the words of the song together. Project the lyrics from the concept slides on MusicplayOnline. When the teacher and class read a text aloud together it enables struggling readers to participate without being in the spotlight. Research suggests that choral reading improves reading fluency, expands vocabulary, and increases students' confidence.

Language Arts/Art: Have students illustrate their favorite part of this song.
